

# Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War WAR MEDAL APPLICATION

Form 5 – Rev. 11/02

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The SUVCW **WAR MEDAL** is authorized for any Brother who has served honorably in any branch of the Armed Forces of the United States during a period of war or military conflict as defined by the Council of Administration.\* Entitlement is determined by the Brother's Camp at a regular meeting of that Camp. A gold bar naming the war or conflict in which the Brother served may be attached to the ribbon of the medal. This bar may not be attached to any other badge of the Order. The **WAR MEDAL** shall NOT be worn at the same time with the MILITARY SERVICE MEDAL. [Ref. REGULATIONS, Chapter V, Article III, Section 3, sub-sections F, G – C&R.]

\* The Council of Administration (as of November 17, 2002) hereby defines the eligibility for the **WAR MEDAL**; for any Brother who has served honorably in any branch of the Armed Forces of the United States, which resulted in the awarding of one or more ribbons and/or medals as authorized by the Congress of the United States, the President of the United States or the Secretary of Defense of the United States and as approved by this Order.
